- B. THAT Committee members provide suggestions for the Opening of the Woollahra Small Sculpture Prize on Wednesday 12 October, 2022 by Tuesday morning on 4 October, 2022

**Discussion points:**

- Vicki Munro explained that Gold Sponsors, Kim Jackson and Scott Farquhar are happy to have their sponsorship listed as per the Sponsorship Proposal. Due to time constraints, they were unable to provide their logo for inclusion in the press release for the Announcement of Finalists and Judges.
- Sebastian Goldspink advised that Nate Ditzler from Texas had withdrawn from the exhibition due to postage difficulties, resulting in a total of 49 finalists.
- Sebastian Goldspink spoke to the report and outlined the following key points:
  - The three judges will attend on Monday 10 October, 2022 to select the winner and highly commended works for 2022. The Mayor will join the judges to select the Mayor's Prize. This information will be sent to Articulate to be embargoed until Wednesday 6.30pm on 12 October, 2022.
  - Wednesday, 12 October, 11am – Media Preview
  - Wednesday, 12 October, 5-6pm – Mayor's Preview to be attended by WSSP Committee, WSSP Sponsors, WSSP judges, Lindy Lee donors, the Public Art Panel and the local State and Federal Members. Clr Grieve asked that whether the Councillors would attend. Clr Shapiro agreed to speak to the Mayor on this matter, prior to the invites being distributed.
  - Wednesday, 12 October, 6pm– Exhibition Opening. Sebastian Goldspink outlined the invite categories for the opening. It was agreed to add previous sponsors; previous judges for the past 5 years; all Members of Parliament including Alex Greenwich, member for Sydney; Senator David Shoebridge: Chris Rath, Member of NSW Legislative Council; the former Chair, Anthony Marano and Natalie Ottolenghi Bradshaw. Aiming for approximately 400 invites with approximately 200-250 people to attend the opening. It was agreed that WSSP Committee members would send through any further invite recommendations to Sebastian Goldspink by Tuesday 4 October, 2022.
  - Clr Grieve asked about the WSSP banners and their locations. It was explained that they would be installed on Friday 30 September from Double Bay to the Woollahra Gallery at Redleaf, with alternating banners promoting the gallery.
