Remember - the appropriate grant stream will also depend on the intent of your project.

Definitions

- **Community organisations include**: not-for-profit, charity registered with the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission, incorporated community groups.
- **Community groups include**: people acting together for a shared interest. Not required to be incorporated.
- Education facilities include: schools, tertiary institutions, non-profit early learning centres, school associated organisations like Parents & Citizens Associations and non-profit out of school hours care groups.
- Businesses include: profit making organisations.
- Sole traders include: an individual running a business.
- Business Sector Support organisations include: business chambers and organisations that have an ABN and carry out the following activities in Woollahra local government area:
 - o support local businesses and economic development
 - market and promote local businesses
 - facilitate educational workshops and seminars, information sharing, business training, and regular networking opportunities
 - o attract local trade, talent, new business and investment
