

Who can apply for Woollahra Council grants?

Remember - the appropriate grant stream will also depend on the intent of your project.

* Individuals or sole traders may apply for these large grants if they are under the auspices of a not-for-profit organization.

Definitions

- **Community organisations include:** not-for-profit, charity registered with the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission, incorporated community groups.
- **Community groups include:** people acting together for a shared interest. Not required to be incorporated.
- **Education facilities include:** schools, tertiary institutions, non-profit early learning centres, school associated organisations like Parents & Citizens Associations and non-profit out of school hours care groups.
- **Businesses include:** profit making organisations.
- **Sole traders include:** an individual running a business.
- **Business Sector Support organisations include:** business chambers and organisations that have an ABN and carry out the following activities in Woollahra local government area:
 - support local businesses and economic development
 - market and promote local businesses
 - facilitate educational workshops and seminars, information sharing, business training, and regular networking opportunities
 - attract local trade, talent, new business and investment
